
## Our facility features:

- The Stavros Niarchos Foundation Advanced Thrombectomy Suite, which houses the Siemens Miyabi Angio-CT Hybrid Suite, the first and only one in the United States
- Diagnostic CT and the thrombectomy procedure occur in the same room, on the same table, resulting in improved efficiency, speed, and quality, and eliminating time consuming transfers
- The potential to cut door-to-puncture time well below the national target of 90 minutes, saving more lives and significantly improving patient outcomes
- Extensive in-house stroke evaluation, rehabilitation, and recovery services
